

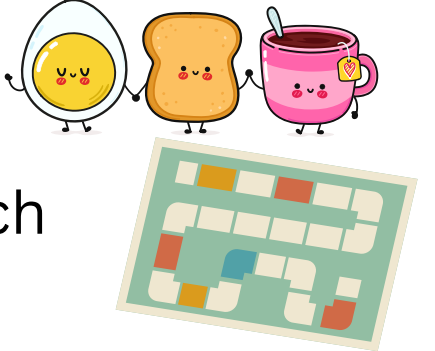

Raffle Fundraiser is Underway.

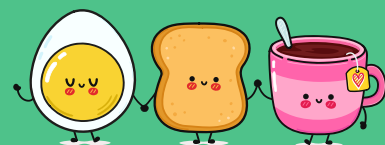

## *Significant Dates in Our Community*

**June 1-3<sup>rd</sup>: Shavuot**-A two-day Jewish holiday that celebrates the completion of the seven-week Omer counting period between Passover and Shavuot.

**June 4-9<sup>th</sup>: The Hajj**-Annual pilgrimage to Mecca that all Muslims must take at least once in their lives.

**June 7<sup>th</sup>: Eid al-Adha**-Eid al-Adha is the Muslim holy day that honors the sacrifice Ibrahim (Abraham) was willing to make in obedience to God's command. Muslims now celebrate this event by sharing a slaughtered animal in three parts: one part for themselves, one for their family, and the third part is given to the needy.
