June is:

Filipino Heritage Month A time to showcase the rich culture and heritage of Filipino Canadians.

Italian Heritage Month A time to showcase the rich culture and heritage of Italian Canadians.

National Indigenous Heritage Month A month to recognize the history, heritage and diversity of First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples in Canada.

Portuguese Heritage Month A time to showcase the rich culture and heritage of Portuguese Canadians.

Pride Season Begins Pride Season is a unifying term that refers to the period between June and September when 2SLGBTQ+ communities and allies come together at different times throughout the summer to spotlight the resilience, talent, and contributions of 2SLGBTQ+ communities in many Canadian cities.

June 23rd - **National Day of Remembrance for Victims of Terrorism**

In memory of those who have lost their lives through acts of terror in Canada and around the world. The day was chosen to coincide with the Anniversary of the Air India Flight 182 tragedy.

June 24th - **St. Jean-Baptiste Day**

In Canada, nearly 10 million people speak French. On Saint-Jean-Baptiste Day and the National Day of Quebec, Francophones across the country show their pride by celebrating their language and their traditions.

The Islamic New Year, also known as the Hijri New Year, marks the start of the first month of the Islamic New Year.

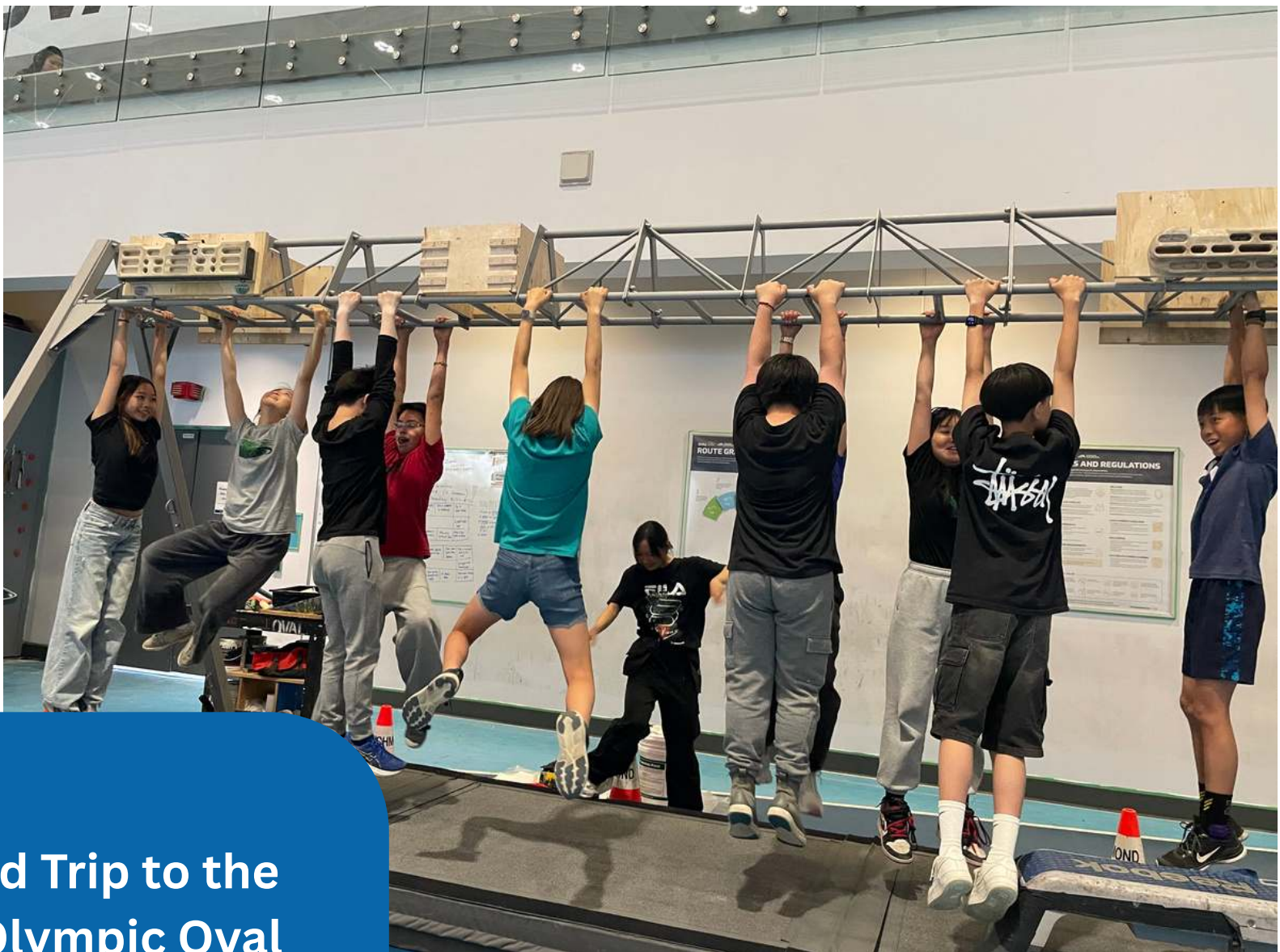
June 27th - **Canadian Multiculturalism Day**
