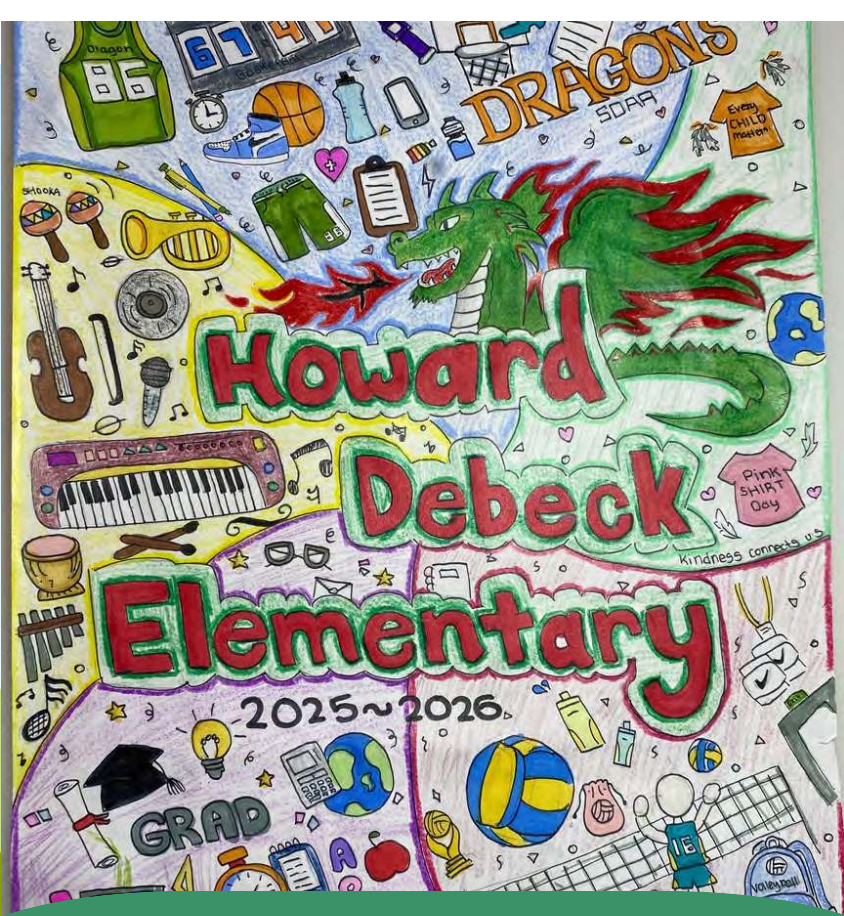
Filipino Heritage Month - A time to showcase the rich culture and heritage of Filipino Canadians.

Portuguese Heritage Month - A time to showcase the rich culture and heritage of Portuguese Canadians.

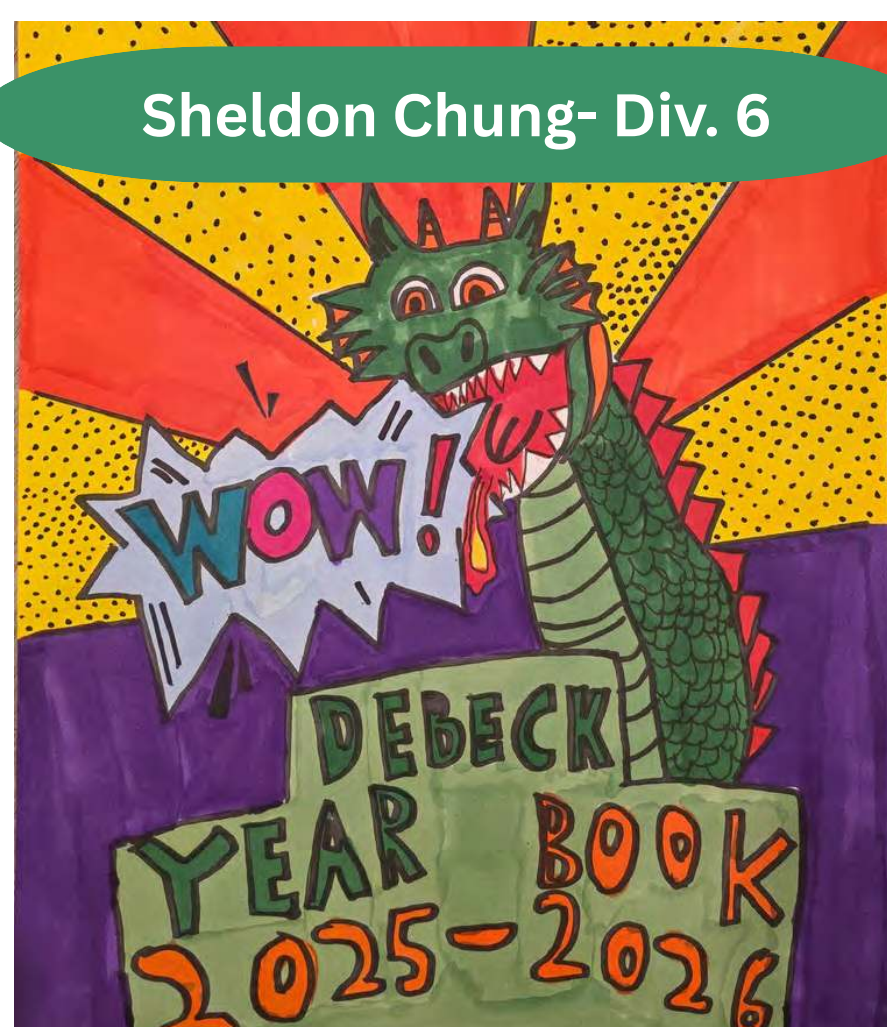
June 16 - Islamic New Year: The Islamic New Year, also known as the Hijri New Year, marks the start of the first month of the Islamic lunar calendar

June 18 - Guru Arjan Martyrdom: A Sikh day of remembrance

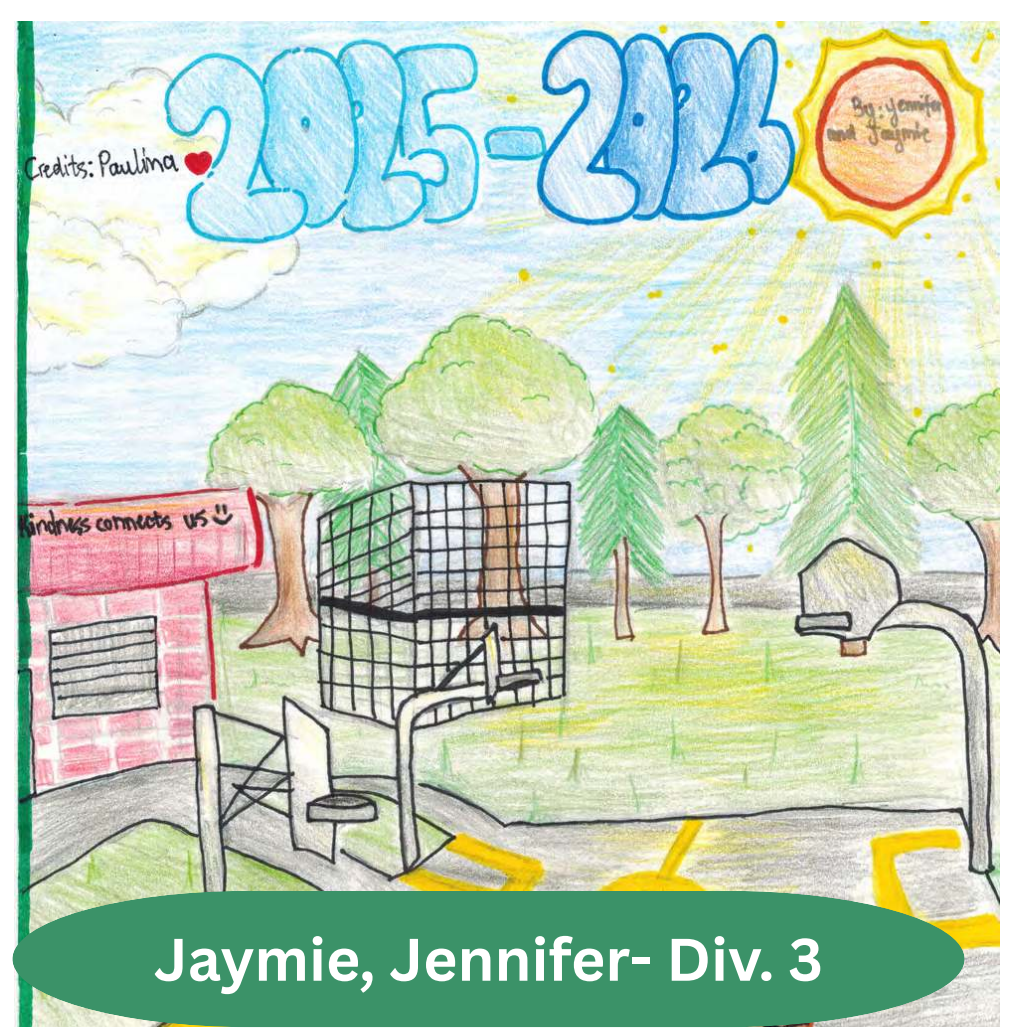
June 21 - National Indigenous Peoples Day: A day to recognize the history, heritage and diversity of First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples in Canada.
