# **PARKING LOT SAFETY**



The parking lot at drop off and pick up has become increasingly unsafe for families. Families are driving too quickly in the parking lot and are not following drop off expectations. By working together, we can all help to make sure that our DeBeck students and families are safe.

Beginning on Monday, Mrs. Anderson and Mrs. Schwartz will be outside patrolling the parking lot at drop off.

Here are the parking lot expectations that we are expecting everyone to follow:

- Please pull up as far as possible in the drop off lane when coming to school in the mornings.
- o Street parking is available on Ash Street and Dayton Avenue
- The drop off lane is for drop off only. You should be parked there for less than a minute (Do **NOT** leave your car in the drop off zone). After dropping off, leave the area immediately.
- o The drive-thru lane is for driving thru, do not drop your child off. This is not a safe place for drop off.

To reduce traffic, consider dropping your child off early or walking to school.
