

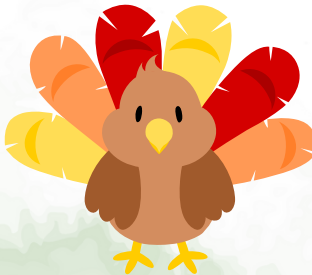

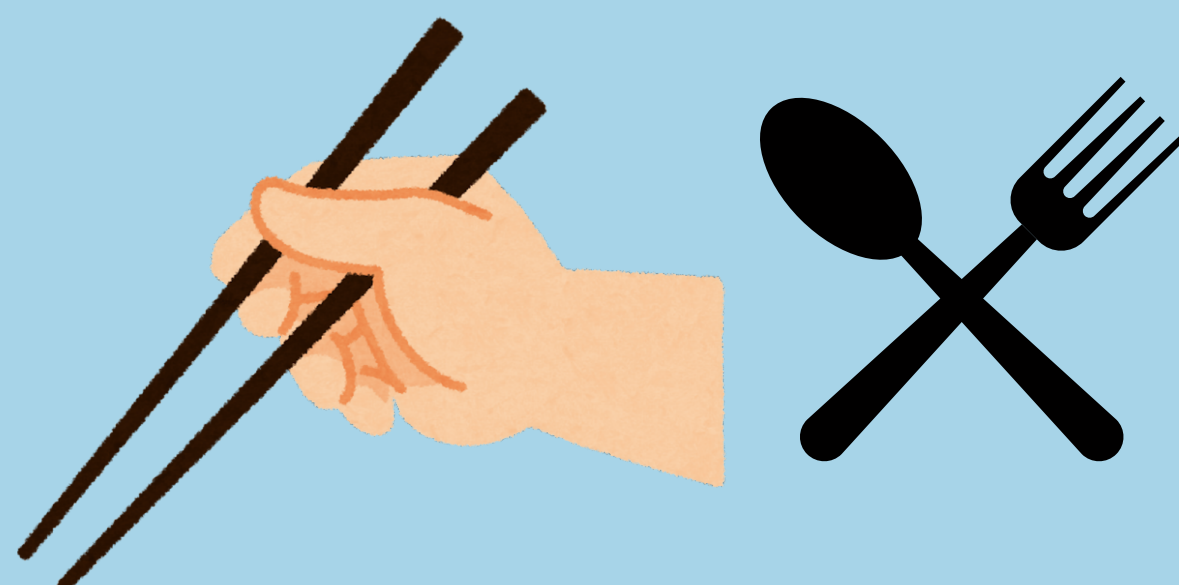

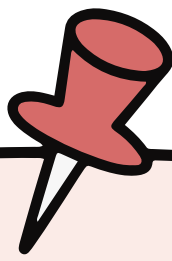
Parent/Teacher Conferences
