Significant Dates in Our Community

March is Irish Heritage Month: March was declared Irish Heritage Month in the House of Commons in 2022. Irish Heritage Month celebrates Irish Canadians' contributions to Canada's story and serves as an opportunity to learn more about Irish-Canadian history.

March 8 - International Women's Day: A time to reflect on progress made, to call for change and to celebrate acts of courage and determination by ordinary women, who have played an extraordinary role in the history of their countries and communities.

March 15 - International Day to Combat Islamophobia: The United Nations General Assembly resolution for this day stresses that terrorism and violent extremism cannot and should not be associated with any religion, nationality, civilization, or ethnic group. It calls for a global dialogue on the promotion of a culture of tolerance and peace, based on respect for human rights and for the diversity of religions and belief.

March 16-20 - Neurodiversity Celebration Week: A worldwide initiative that challenges stereotypes and misconceptions about neurodevelopmental disorders and learning disabilities.

March 19-20 - Nowruz – Iranian (Persian) New Year: Also known as Baha'i, Iranian, or Persian New Year. It begins on the spring equinox and marks the beginning of Farvardin, the first month of the Solar Hijri calendar.

March 19-20 - Eid-al-Fitr: Many Muslims in Canada celebrate Eid al-Fitr on the first day of Shawwal in the Islamic calendar. It marks the end of the month-long fast of Ramadan and the start of a feast that lasts up to three days in some countries. The date is dependent on the sighting of the new crescent moon.

March 19-27 - Chaitra Navratri: A Hindu nine-day festival to celebrate the first day of the Hindu calendar.

March 21 - International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination: A United Nations day of remembrance and action. Observed annually on the day that 69 people lost their lives to the hands of the police in Sharpeville, South Africa, while demonstrating peacefully against apartheid "pass laws" in 1960.

March 21 - World Down Syndrome Day: World Down Syndrome Day is on 21 March every year. It is a global awareness day which has been officially observed by the United Nations since 2012. The goal is to help people understand and support those with Down syndrome better. The date being the 21st day of the 3rd month was chosen to represent the triplication (trisomy) of the 21st chromosome which causes Down syndrome.

March 27 - Ram Navami: A Hindu Spring festival that falls on the ninth day of the month Chaitra according to the Hindu calendar.
