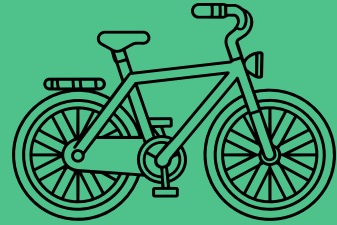

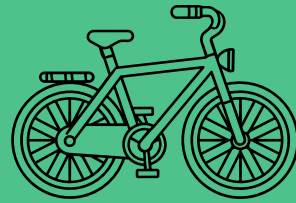

Traffic Congestion & Student Safety

Traffic congestion at drop-off and pick-up continues to be challenging. Cars are being parked in non-designated areas, and some families continue to drop their children off in the middle of the parking lot driveways. This creates a dangerous situation, as other vehicles swerve around stopped cars and children exiting vehicles are often in drivers' blind spots.

Our neighbours on Ashby Place have also contacted the school about cars idling for extended periods and blocking driveways. Ashby Place is a residential street and is not intended to be used as an extension of the school parking lot. By-Law officers will be monitoring the area over the next few weeks. Please help keep our students and community safe by using designated drop-off areas and being respectful of our neighbours. Consider walking or cycling to school for the health benefits and to reduce congestion.

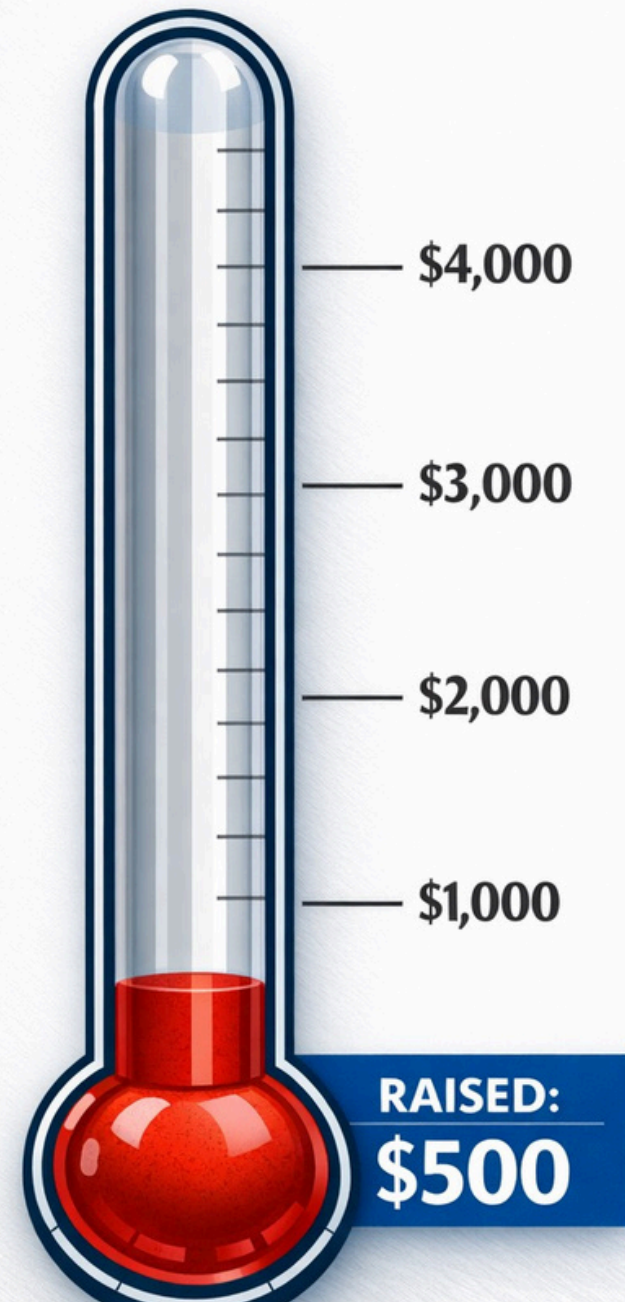

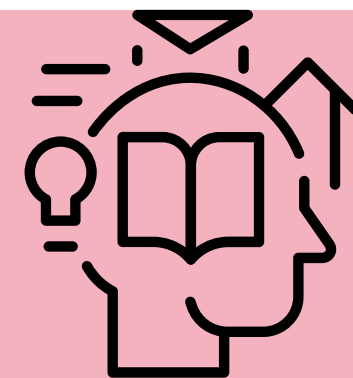

Significant Dates in Our Community

March 31- April 1- Hanuman Jayanti- A Hindu religious festival that celebrates the birth of Hindu God Hanuman

April 1-9- Pesach or Passover- Holiday that commemorates the Jewish liberation and escape to Egypt.

April 6- Ram Navami- A Hindu Spring festival that falls on the ninth day of the month Chaitra according to the Hindu calendar.

April 3 - Good Friday- Also known as Holy Friday, Great Friday, Great and Holy Friday, or Friday of the Passion of the Lord, is a solemn Christian holy day commemorating the crucifixion of Jesus and his death at Calvary (Golgotha).

April 5- Easter- Easter Sunday (Easter or Pascha). The principal festival of the Christian church, which celebrates the Resurrection of Jesus Christ on the third day after his Crucifixion.

April 6 - Easter Monday- In Western Christianity, Easter Monday is the second day of Eastertide, as well as the second day in the Octave of Easter.
